

Oberlo Prohibited Product Policy

The following items are considered prohibited products by Oberlo and Marketplace Suppliers are not permitted to list or sell these type of products via the Oberlo Marketplace:

- a. Alcohol;
- b. Bicycles, motorcycles or helmets;
- c. Children's car seats or children's harnesses;
- d. Counterfeit products or unauthorized products (see definitions below);
- e. Dangerous or hazardous products (see definitions below);
- f. Drugs, drug paraphernalia, or products offered for sale and/or sold in connection with health claims;
- g. Human remains or body parts, including hair and teeth;
- h. Lighters;
- i. Live animals or animal parts;
- j. Non-tangible products such as, for example, virtual and digital goods;
- k. Physical or digital gift cards;
- l. Pornography, including pornographic images and videos;
- m. Tobacco, electronic cigarettes or other smokeable products;
- n. Piercing or tattoo guns;
- o. Plants or plant seeds;
- p. Products that have been recalled by government authorities or manufacturers of the product;
- q. Weapons and related products, such as, for example, firearms, archery equipment, chemical and/or biological weapons or ammunition;
- r. Any product or a product listing that would otherwise violate the letter or spirit of Shopify's Acceptable Use Policy available at <https://www.shopify.com/legal/aup>, including but not limited to child exploitation, harassment, bullying, defamation, threats, hateful content or illegal activities.
- s. Any product or a product listing that would otherwise violate the letter or spirit of Shopify's Payments Terms of Service available at: <https://www.shopify.com/legal/terms-payments-us>.

Definitions

An **unauthorized product** is a product that is illegally imported or exported.

A **counterfeit product** is a product that: (a) meets any of the criteria below; and (b) the Marketplace Supplier has not obtained the rights owner's or licensor's permission to offer for sale, and/or sell the product:

1. The product contains or imitates an intellectual property, including copyright, trademark, patent or an industrial design;
2. The product is sold under a name that is identical or substantially indistinguishable from such intellectual property; or
3. The product contains images of celebrities or famous individuals.

A **dangerous product** is a chemical, medical, cosmetic, health or food product that has been recalled, or has been identified by government authorities as toxic, dangerous or otherwise unsafe, in the jurisdiction in which the Marketplace Supplier resides or the jurisdiction in which the product is shipped to.

A **hazardous product** is an explosive or flammable product, a biohazardous or toxic substance including poison, a gas or radioactive material.

Oberlo reserves the right to modify and/or change any of the rules contained in this Prohibited Product Policy at any time without prior notice. Such changes will be effective as of the date of posting or as expressly communicated to Supplier(s).
